



Mustang[®] Maxx Insecticide & Steward[®] EC Insecticide Alfalfa Assurance Program

An early application of Mustang Maxx insecticide or Steward EC insecticide in alfalfa for control of weevils followed by a later application of Steward EC insecticide with residual control is a best practice for effective control in first cutting alfalfa hay.

When one of the following combinations of treatments are applied within the labeled timing and a third application is required prior to making the first cutting due to economical infestation of weevil – such determination shall be made solely by an FMC representative or an FMC authorized agent. FMC will cover up to \$4.00/A for the third treatment.
