



Herbicide Fall Burndown Assurance Program

Program Description:

Whether you need short, convenient and rotation flexible application or long-lasting residual protection until spring, FMC has the right product program to accomplish your burndown and weed control needs.

Three Qualifying Programs:

When using a burndown application following the FMC recommendations below at the minimum specified rates, growers are eligible for an assurance payment toward the purchase of re-spray materials if they do not maintain commercially acceptable 90 percent control of labeled weeds* versus an untreated check.

Crusher® herbicide 1 oz./A + glyphosate 22-32 oz./A + 2,4-D 24 fl. oz./A OR dicamba 16 fl. oz./A	90% control of labeled weeds through April 1, 2019	\$5.00/A toward the re-spray materials purchase

FMC Burndown Recommendation – Program 3 Fall Control of Winter Annuals Plus Residual for Early Spring Annuals.	Assurance Benefit	Program Payment Timing
Authority® MTZ DF herbicide 10-14 oz./A OR Authority XL herbicide OR Authority First DF herbicide 3.5-5 oz./A + glyphosate 22-32 oz./A + 2,4-D 24 fl. oz./A OR dicamba 16 fl. oz./A	90% control of labeled weeds through May 1, 2019	\$7.00/A toward the re-spray materials purchase

Application Guidelines

- Apply in the fall to actively growing weeds free from stress from drought, freeze damage, etc.
- Include a surfactant (NIS, COC, or MSO) to all treatments for maximum activity.
- Best applied after soil temps reach 55° F and falling for increased residual longevity and performance.
- Do not apply to frozen soils.
- Check with individual product labels before use for geographic, pH, soil texture and rotational crop restrictions.

Program Requirements:

1. Leave a representative check strip in each field and mark its location for comparison of control levels.
2. Products must be applied according to label use directions.

*Weeds with known resistance are excluded
